August 26, 2012 – The Jewish Community Relations Council of NY joined the NY Mets for the 15th Annual Jewish Heritage Day celebration at Citi Field. JCRC-NY staff members received the Spirit Award on the field during the pre-game ceremony. Entertainment was provided by the Papparim Dance Ensemble, directed by Ruth Goodman, and Jewish A Cappella Six13, which also returned during the seventh inning stretch for an inspirational rendition of “God Bless America.” Ike Davis became the first player of Jewish heritage to win a Mets game with two home runs, including one in the bottom of the ninth inning, as the Mets defeated the Houston Astros 2-1.
